Accessing My Health Declarations


When you are ready to begin click on the **Start My Health Declarations** link

A window will open with the ImmiAccount home page. From this window you can:

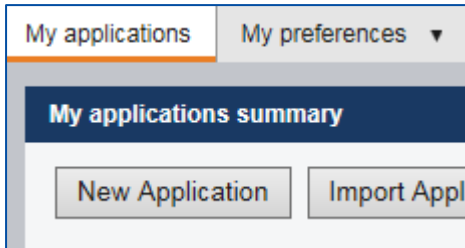
- Login to ImmiAccount if you already have an account set up for yourself, or
- Create a new ImmiAccount to access the department's online services, including My Health Declarations, by clicking on the **Create ImmiAccount** button.

Note: You must have an ImmiAccount in order to use My Health Declarations.

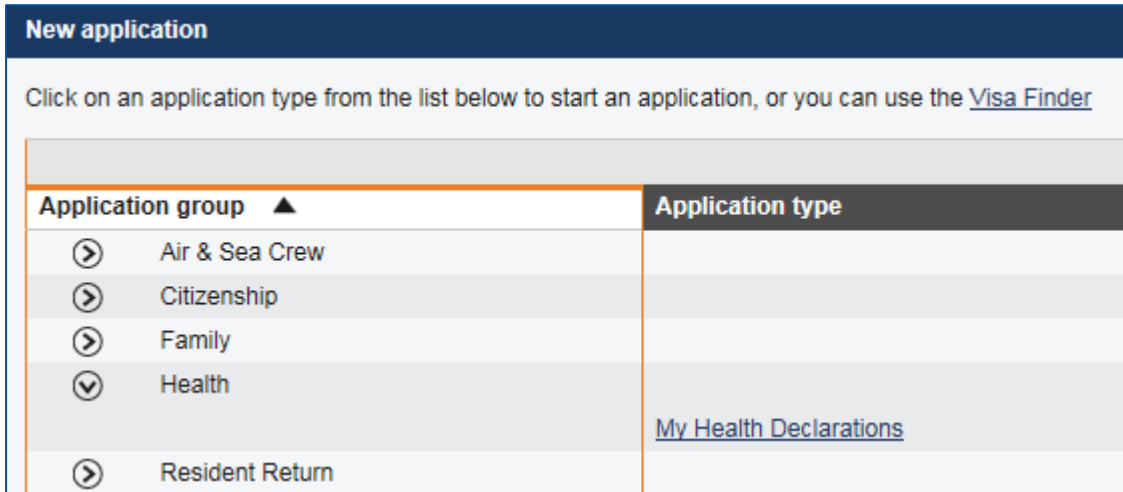

Then click on the **My Health Declarations** link by expanding the Health application group.



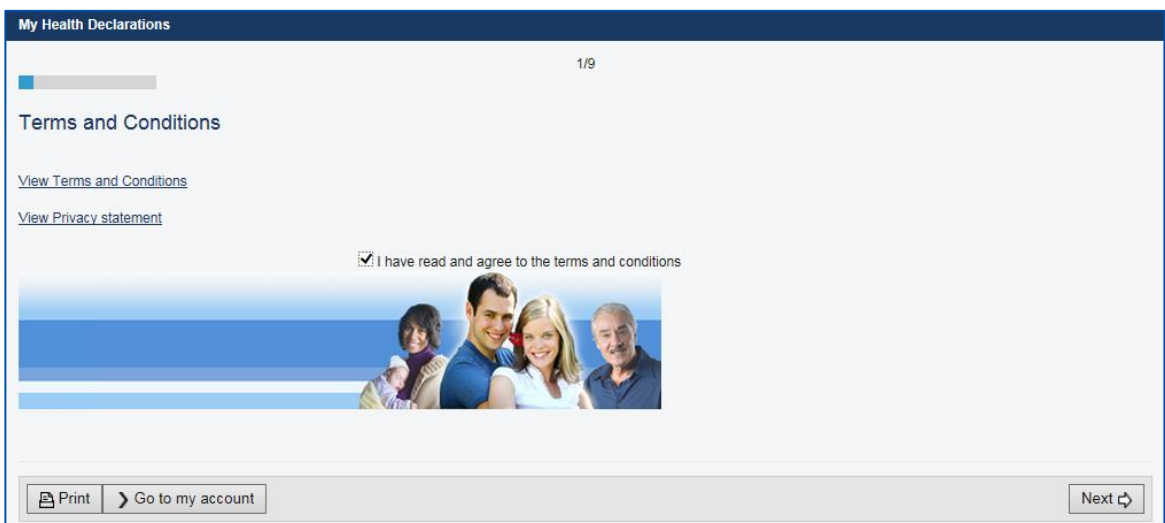
